## Pro-Israel Indoctrination Not Fully Effective


A good effort...but not good enough.

"The U.S. is basically doing the same thing to Arab and Muslim immigrants, and that's doing an excellent job of keeping us safe while protecting our status as the greatest democracy in the world."
